Ticket Process and check-in

- 1. Check-in tent located in the parking lot behind the stadium.
- 2. Temp checks prior to receiving tickets.
- 3. Wristbands given to designate the deck or area they are allowed to be located.
- 4. Fans must rsvp for a time they would like to attend/pick up their order.
- 5. Once they are rsvp'd they will receive more info and a map of what they need / can do when showing up (depending on what we decide the field or decks will be shown)
- 6. We will receive 150 orders or less per wave
- 7. This system will let vendors and us know exactly how much to plan on making for each time frame to keep food at the perfect temperature

Tacos

- 1. 9 Taco Vendors to be setup in the parking lot
 - a. Each vendor makes 1 type of taco (chicken, beef, fish, etc)
 - b. Each vendor will make a predetermined allotment of their taco
- 2. Taco to be included in batches of 3 with 3 options
- 3. Tacos box sorting station
 - a. Tacos will be sorted into a boxes and transported to their respective locations

Alcoholic Drinks

- 1. 3 Beer options. 3 Margarita options. 10 brands of tequila options.
- 2. Non Reusable cups
- 3. Whitecaps employees to pour drinks.
- 4. To limit alcohol consumption, no additional tokens to be sold at the event. Only in advance.
- 5. Lines to be spaced and socially distant.

Parking

• Free parking to ensure a touchless experience.

Vendor Setup

- Vendors will need to prep food under a tent (10x10)
 - We can provide or they can bring their own
- Water will need to be available
- Vendors will be given a schedule of how many tacos they need to make per wave.

Covid Policies:

- Lines will be arranged and marked to encourage proper distancing between pods of guests.
- Stanchions and/or spacing markers will promote proper social distancing between fans waiting in lines.
- Before each wave, ballpark seats, tables and high touch areas will be sanitized.

- Fans are required to wear a mask whenever moving around the ballpark, restrooms, lines and in food and beverage areas.
- Fans are highly encouraged to check their temperature before the event. If a fan does
 not feel well or is running a fever over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, the Event asks that
 they do not attend the event. Please call your ticket representative before the event to
 discuss alternate options.
- Disinfectant wipes to be accessible for fans to wipe down their seat and high touch areas
- Trash can lids to remain off or open each event to allow touchless access to receptacles.
- Bathroom attendants on site to limit the number of guests in the restroom at one time and encourage social distancing.
- Bag checks will have heightened safety guidelines, and clear bags are highly encouraged for a contactless experience.
- For ticket taking the pod leader will hold out all tickets and an event employee will check each ticket without touching. To alleviate crowding, fans will be asked to immediately go up the concourse.
- The event will highly encourage contactless credit card and electronic payments at all concession, merchandise and ticket locations throughout the ballpark.
- Signage will be posted throughout the ballpark reminding fans of the current State of Mi recommendations and CDC guidelines.
- Handouts will still occur with protective measures in place, i.e. cups will be handed out with gloves.

Miscellaneous

- No new tickets will be sold for the event
- Masks are required
- All lines will be socially distanced
- Whitecaps provide barricades
- Growlers bring hand washing stations
- 15 minute last call
- No limes or salt
- No wristbands
- Temporary permits for 2 vendors
- Temperature checks for fans as they enter
- Drink options for beer (Modelo, Pacifico, Tecate)
